PAPER – blue bin

- PUT IN**
- paper and cardboard packaging
 - catalogues, fliers, prospectuses
 - newspapers and magazines
 - school and office paper, printed paper
 - notebooks and books
 - packaging paper
 - paper bags
-
- DO NOT PUT IN**
- used paper towels and tissues
 - foil coated paper
 - oily or very dirty paper
 - milk and drink cartons (so called Tetra Paks)
 - paper fertiliser, cement and other building material bags
 - wallpaper
 - disposable nappies and sanitary towels
 - oily and disposable paper packaging and disposable dishes



METALS AND PLASTICS – yellow bin

- PUT IN**
- empty and flattened plastic bottles with tops on
 - milk and juice cartons (so called Tetra Paks) and multiple-materials packaging
 - plastic domestic detergents and cosmetics packaging
 - plastic bags, sacks and other foils
 - empty food and drink cans
 - aluminium foil
 - scrap metal and non-ferrous metal
 - jar lids and bottle tops
-
- DO NOT PUT IN**
- medication packaging and used medical products
 - engine oil and automotive chemicals packaging
 - spare car parts
 - used batteries and accumulators
 - paint and lacquer cans and containers
 - used electrical appliances or white goods
 - styrofoam
 - toys



GLASS – green bin

- PUT IN**
- empty drink and food bottles (lids and tops removed)
 - empty jars (lids removed)
 - empty glass cosmetics packaging
-
- DO NOT PUT IN**
- ceramics, flower pots, ceramic ware, porcelain, crystal glassware
 - spectacles
 - kitchen dishes, tampered glass tableware and kitchenware, heat-resistant glass
 - vigil lights with wax
 - light bulbs, fluorescent bulbs and reflectors
 - medication, solvent and engine oil packaging
 - mirrors
 - glass and reinforced panes
 - monitors and TV lamps
 - thermometers and syringes



BIO –brown bin

- PUT IN**
- vegetable and fruit peelings and waste
 - trimmings and cuttings
 - grass clippings, leaves, flowers
 - food waste
 - used paper towels and tissues
-
- DO NOT PUT IN**
- animal bones and raw meat
 - ash
 - medication
 - impregnated wood
 - chipboard and fibreboard
 - soil and stones
 - animal faeces and faeces soiled materials (including cat litter and bedding for rodents)
 - used hygiene products including disposable nappies
 - other municipal waste (including hazardous waste)



NON-RECYCLABLE – grey / black bin

Put in anything that cannot go into any of the other bins or cannot be recycled

- PUT IN**
- foil coated paper
 - oily and dirty paper
 - oily disposable paper dishes and disposable dishes
 - used hygiene products including disposable nappies
 - animal bones and raw meat
 - animal faeces and faeces soiled materials (including cat litter and bedding for rodents)
 - clothes, small toys
 - styrofoam from households (such as from packaging of appliances and white goods and disposable styrofoam dishes)
 - ceramics, flower pots, ceramic ware, porcelain, crystal glassware
 - spectacles, mirrors
 - heat-resistant glass and tampered glass tableware and kitchenware
 - vigil lights with wax

- DO NOT PUT IN**
- building and demolition waste
 - bulky waste
 - hazardous waste
 - used electrical appliances or white goods
 - spare car parts and tyres
 - engine oil and lubricant packaging
 - paint and lacquer cans and containers
 - batteries and accumulators
 - medication and used medical products
 - needles and syringes
